The Association continues to be a very active body, with members in all parts of the country and a few abroad. Since nearly all are, or were, owners of SeaWych's, most of which were built from kits, there is a wealth of experience and knowledge freely available to all members.

This pool of expertise comes to a focus in the "SeaWych Modifications Manual" "Owners Manual" and in the owners association "Newsletter". The latter is a quarterly publication containing technical articles, advice about forthcoming sailing and social events as well as stacks of stories – humorous, poignant, serious etc.

SWOA operates at both national and local level, e.g. the annual SWOA rally at Bembridge, IOW, and is a family-oriented organisation which positively encourages participation by younger members. Children and grandchildren who might join with you in SWOA events are always welcome.

The aims of the association have not changed, though the popularity of the social activities has caused the Association to allow Membership for those who do not own a SeaWych – or no boat at all - but who wish to belong to the SWOA.
